Our identity does not come from our brokenness, but from who God says we are.

I am God's workmanship, created in Christ to do good works. (Eph 2:10)

God is always with me. He will not leave me. (Deuteronomy 31:6)

God is my Comforter. (2 Corinthians 1:3-5)

I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength. (Philippians 4:13)

I have the mind of Christ. (1 Corinthians 2:16)

I am the righteousness of God in Jesus Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:21)

I have the Greater One living in me; greater is He Who is in me than he who is in the world. (<u>1 John 4:4</u>) It is not I who live, but Christ lives in me. (<u>Galatians 2:20</u>)

**TODAYS VERSE: MATTHEW 10: 37–39** "He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me; and he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.<sup>38</sup> And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me.<sup>39</sup> He who has found his <sup>[a]</sup> life will lose it, and he who has lost his <sup>[b]</sup> life for My sake will find it.

<u>JOHN 19:19–22</u> Pilate also wrote an inscription and put it on the cross. It was written, "JESUS THE NAZARENE, THE KING OF THE JEWS." Therefore many of the Jews read this inscription, for the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city; and it was written In Hebrew, Latin *and* in Greek. So the chief priests of the Jews were saying to Pilate, "Do not write, 'The King of the Jews'; but that He said, 'I am King of the Jews.'" Pilate answered, "What I have written I have written."

MATTHEW 27:25-26 And all the people said, "His blood shall be on us and on our

*children!*" Then he released Barabbas for them; but after having Jesus scourged, he handed Him over to be crucified

The cross is: God's gift of LOVE for all to receive,

- 1) the ultimate demonstration of God's love
- 2) the source of ongoing supernatural grace
- 3) the basis of healings and miracles today
- 4) the foundation of Satan's total demise and defeat
- 5) the door to God's secret wisdom
- 6) the source of true freedom
- 7) the way of entrance into God's all-sufficient power and provision
- 8) the truth for forgiveness, victory, abundance living today
- 9) the historical event that changed everything for any who apply it to their lives
- 10) the center of life and death, of who I am; Who He is: What He has done for me
- 11) The Gift to be received with nothing added
