To Be Tested---by Satan---after 40 days of fasting---Satan came---<u>Matthew 6:9-13</u> "Pray like this, Our Father who is in heaven, Your Name is Holy. Your kingdom come and Your will be done here on earth just like it is in Heaven. Father give us our daily provisions, and forgive us our sins as we forgive those who have done us wrong. Don't let our temptation be more than we can handle but rescue us from ourselves and the Devil. For Your Kingdom and your Power and Your Glory are forever! Amen and AMEN" Matthew 26:39 And He went a little beyond them and fell on His face and

prayed, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from Me; but not what I want but Your will be done."

<u>QUESTION</u>: Did Jesus follow His own teaching on how to pray? <u>QUESTION</u>: Did you notice Jesus request or temptation had to do with food again?

Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and said to His disciples, *"Sit here while I go over there and pray."* And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be grieved and distressed. Then He said to them, *"My soul is deeply grieved, to the point of death; remain here and keep watch with Me."* 

And He went a little beyond *them*, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, *"My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will."* And He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, *"So, you men could not keep watch with Me for one hour? Keep watching and praying that you may not enter into temptation; the spirit is willing, but the flesh is <u>weak."</u> He went away again a second time and prayed, saying, <i>"My Father, if this cannot pass away unless I drink it, Your will be done."* Again He came and found them sleeping, for their eyes were heavy. And He left them again, and went away and prayed a third time, saying the same thing once more. Then He came to the disciples and said to them, *"Are you still sleeping and resting? Behold, the hour is at hand and the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners.* <sup>46</sup> Get up, let us be going; behold, *the one who betrays Me is at hand!"* 

**QUESTION**: Are you a disciple of Jesus?

**<u>QUESTION</u>**: How well do you do at following His instructions? Example:

How about Deuteronomy 6:6-7 "These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up." QUESTION:: So what are the words?

"Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one! You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might."

**QUESTION:** How well are we doing? Or are we sleeping?

**QUESTION**: What is the difference, if any, from being unselfishness and virtue of Love?

C. S. Lewis said, "The negative idea of Unselfishness carries with it the suggestion not primarily of securing good things for others, but of going without them ourselves, as if our abstinence and not their happiness was the important point. I do not think this is the Christian virtue of Love."
