Martha Whiting Post "This morning I'd like to think about our set prayer time which is good, but I'd like to suggest changing our mind-set from orchestrated prayer to a lifestyle that includes a sustained running conversation with the Lord throughout the day. Worried? Unload your concerns before God right then. Disappointed by a conflict? Immediately share it with the Lord and ask for His intervention. Confused by a problem? Ask God for insight, understanding, and discernment. Don't save up your problems for the next time you pray. Talk with God moment by moment as you experience life. PRAY AS YOU GO!"

My daughter-in-law, Jenny Whiting, wrote to me yesterday this thought: "I like the thought that we are to arrange our day around God not have Him arrange the day around us." That puts our God at the center of our lives as to what His desires for us and from us. The scripture today is from Micah 6:8 and is this: "O people, the Lord has told you what is good, and this is what he requires of you: to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God."

<u>Still Thinking:</u> Do we pray with the intent to get what we want from God? Do we try to manipulate or influence God in our prayers? In our prayers for healing either spiritual or physical or deliverance both ours and in others, are we really trying to "Control" God with the outcome that we want to see?

So how do we pray and bring our petitions to Him? "Ask anything in My Name and I will give it to you." (John 14:13-14) Is there a difference between a controlling prayer, maybe even done in faith, maybe even done with scripture verses to back up our request, with the intent to manipulate the outcome in our favor and a yielded prayer, "Not my will but thin be done?"

Prayer is a condition of my heart, either abandoned in Him or full of me.

More Thinking: Matthew 7:7-11 Jesus said, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. ⁸ For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. ⁹ Or what man is there among you who, when his son asks for a loaf, will give him a stone? ¹⁰ Or if he asks for a fish, he will not give him a snake, will he? ¹¹ If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him! Do you always give your children what they want?

And the wind died down and it became perfectly calm. ⁴⁰ And He said to them, "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?" ⁴¹ They became very much afraid and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey Him?"

To Find Beauty in your Storm, stop and think; what, if anything, gave you peace in that storm? We all experience storms in our lives at some point, some harder and more violent than others. Is it really possible to find beauty and peace in every storm? That depends...Who is in your boat?

If you're going through a storm right now, have you discovered the Prince of Peace in the middle of it, or do you only feel like you are dying? Are you so raped up in the pain and trial that you can't see anything good in your life coming from this storm? Here's the Real Truth: God's will for our lives is peace. He left his peace with us. "Peace beyond what the world can give." (John 14:27) Peace like that can best be defined as not the absence of trouble in your lives BUT THE PRESENCE OF CHRIST. He is **the key** to my peace, **seeing** <u>God</u> in <u>all</u> <u>my circumstances</u> in my every storm "Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful." There is Power in the Name of JESUS. "Wait Patiently with Me."
