TRUST=Waiting in Me; Attitude of expecting; Read Word let Spirit illuminate; See Me in everything!

STILL Thinking: Do you have a storm brewing in your life? Where is God in it? "Think PRESENT." "He Lives in your heart!!" "His Resurrection LIFE is mine TODAY: Our enemy has sent a storm into my life to shake me up! But something is stirring---the Angel rolls back the stone---To let me "IN"---new life in me is awakened!! New Trust---Resurrection Life—Activated in me with POWER! New Empowerment Power to Silence the storm---Peace and Confidence in Him. I Speak to my storm. GET out of my boat, my comfort zone, and Walk on the Water. JESUS is calling "COME" (Mark 4: 37-41)

GRACE: True Story: I left work early so I could have some uninterrupted study time right before the final in my Youth Issues class. When I got to class, everybody was doing their last minute studying. The teacher came in and said he would review with us for just a little bit before the test. We went through the review, most of it right on the study guide, but there were some things he was reviewing that I had never heard of. When questioned about it, he said that they were in the book and we were responsible for everything in the book. We couldn't really argue with that.

Finally it was time to take the test. "Leave them face down on the desk until everyone has one and I'll tell you to start," our professor instructed.

When we turned them over, every answer on the test was filled in! The bottom of the last page said the following:

"This is the end of the Final Exam. All the answers on your test are correct. You will receive an 'A' on the final exam. The reason you passed the test is because the creator of the test took it for you. All the work you did in preparation for this test did not help you get the A. You have just experienced...grace."

He then went around the room and asked each student individually, "What is your grade? Do you deserve the grade you are receiving? How much did all your studying for this exam help you achieve your final grade?"

Now I am not a crier by any stretch of the imagination, but I had to fight back tears when answering those questions and thinking about how the Creator has passed the test for me.

Discussion afterward went like this: "I have tried to teach you all semester that you are a recipient of grace. I've tried to communicate to you that you need to demonstrate this gift as you work with young people. Don't hammer them; they are not the enemy. Help them, for they will carry on your ministry if it is full of GRACE!"

Talking about how some of us had probably studied hours and some just a few minutes but had all received the same grade, he pointed to a story Jesus told in Matthew 20. The owner of a vineyard hired people to work in his field and agreed to pay them a certain amount. Several different times during the day, he hired more workers. When it was time to pay them, they all received the same amount. When the ones who had been hired first thing in the morning began complaining, the boss said, "Should you be angry because I am kind?" (Matthew 20:15).

The teacher said he had never done this kind of final before and probably would never do it again, but because of the content of many of our class discussions, he felt like we needed to experience grace.

Have you thanked your Creator today because of the grace you have experienced?

<u>QUESTION</u>: What happened between John 19: 42 and 20:1? Therefore because of the Jewish day of preparation, since the tomb was nearby, they laid Jesus there. 20:1 Now on the first *day* of the week Mary Magdalene came----SATURDAY

<u>QUESTION</u>: Where do we live our life? Is it In the horror of Friday? In the despair of Saturday or in the Resurrection Power of Sunday?

C. S. Lewis said, "When you place a dead seed in the ground, something in the dirt calls to something in the seed. "Hey seed! Wake up! Send me a little root." Then something above the earth says to the seed, "Send up a little shoot." And the seed does. The seed becomes a plant or a tree, and it produces fruit. It achieves its destiny. But it could never happen if the seed didn't die first.

There is a second revolution. This time we know the revolutionary's name. We know where he lived. We know how he lived. We know what he taught. We know how he died. This is, Jesus said, the way life works. You have to be willing to sacrifice something if anything is ever going to be the way it is supposed to be. No sacrifice, no harvest. Only it isn't seeds this time; *this time it's you*.

What got released on Sunday was hope. Not hope that life would turn out well. Hope that called people to die: die to selfishness and sin and fear and greed, die to the lesser life of a lesser self so that a greater self might be born. And many people did. This hope changed things. Because of their belief in the resurrection of the body. Because of Sunday.

Jesus released a new kind of hope. Where are you most aware of a need for this kind of hope in your life right now? What lesser thing do you sense God may be asking you to die to?

QUESTION: What does "DOA" stand for or mean to you?

TODAY'S ENCOURAGING WORD: "I have a question for you, if you were to FOCUS on Me completely today, what would your expectation be? Would you be looking for evil to defeat you spiritually or would you let fear invade your thinking? Would your circumstances and cares of life bring you down to despair? Or—Do you let the burden of your own failures and sin cloud out MY ever present presence?

If that is you, then IT'S TIME to REFOCUS!

My next question to you is, can you TRUST Me? OR---Do you trust ME? How far---do you trust Me? Do you see Me in your mirror in the morning? Do you see Me as you drive? Do you see Me as you study My Word? Let Me put it this way---when don't you see Me? Let Me help you change your focus today. I want you to know that I Am visible---as visible as you come to expect to see Me----expect to see Me doing battle in you and through you today.

IT"S TIME for you to TRUST ME!!

My last question is, Where or in whom do you place your confidence? In yourself; In money; government system; religious relationships or in the Living God?

I know that your answer is 'the Living God' but you don't---live there---do you? Here is My Call to you today: Look away from your problems, family problems, government problems, personal problems of failure or fears and look into My Eyes and see the Power that I have to break every chain, defeat every spirit that rises up against you---the Truth is---I Have Already done IT---just for you. Look into My Eye and get New Life From My View-Point—Come with expectation, confidence and Trusting Faith that I Am very much involved in everything you do, everywhere you go; Receive and experience My LOVE, JOY, LIFE---- now give it all away." (Romans 8:1; Psalm 121:5; Matthew 13:44; Romans 10:17; Exodus 14:13)
